Also back two awnings completed – agreed to review the purchase order and vendor agreement regarding the substitution of particleboard for plywood as underlayment.

Ray reported the pump cover has been installed on # 4; top dressing has begun; additional bridge ready to be installed; replacement of the 'Welch/Gallagher' bench on # 4 tee is delayed to next year due to sourcing issues (wire coated mesh); a lot of tough weather- staff has identified and is repairing circled areas on # 8 fairway and in the rough between # 8 and # 2; greens were rolled both a.m. and p.m. this past weekend for the club championships; agreed to review the cart path situation and options.
