# TREASURER'S REPORT

Sean reported overall, the club is in a strong financial position. Despite the weather in July and August we have had tremendous support from the membership this year in all areas of revenue. This includes strong bar revenue, cart revenue, and greens fees revenue. Our cash position in our operating and money market accounts exceeds our position at this time in August 2020 by ~\$172,000. This increase does not include the additional \$314,000 from NGRID payments, PPP loan proceeds, ERTCs and initiation fees we have set aside in a restricted fund. The operating funds cash will be impacted by the project on #9 tee and the down payment that is being made (2/3 payment) on the patio furniture, however we are still expected to end the year in a favorable position.

Budgeting process is underway with a draft scheduled for October, to be finalized in November.

Brian Gleason entered the meeting at 6:39 p.m.

#### **HOUSE COMMITTEE**

Donna reported complaints of an occasional 'odor' downstairs that seems to come and go, seems to be plumbing related – Sean to contact a plumber, and also begin snaking drains and pipes as needed; rear awnings are complete (both pro shop and patio – kitchen awning removed), to review use of particleboard with vendor; Saturday night there will be a DJ on the patio for the Senior Ryder Cup and Solheim Cup events; Sean's party was a great success, special thanks to the many members and vendors who donated and contributed; upstairs has been quiet, but beginning to see some increase in interest.

The open Assistant Manager's position was reviewed – agreed, subject to Sean's agreeing, to fill the hours with current staff and delay hiring until after the holidays. And in preparation for the new season.
