## Board of Directors Meeting \*

Minutes of Sunday, December 20, 2020

President Jason Frediani called the meeting to order at 10:04 a.m. with all nine (9) board members present, and welcomed Treasurer Sean Moriarty and Tournament Chair Brain Gleason to their first regular meeting of the board...

### SECRETARY

The minutes of the 11/22/20 regular meeting, and the 12/3 (zoom), the 12/5(1), and the 12/5 (2) special meetings were presented for review.

**Motion** by Ray Costello, seconded by Pat Donovan to accept the minutes of the above minutes, with one correction. Vote unanimous - Motion passed.

**Motion** by Andrea Dutile, seconded by Pat Donovan to approve the four (4) changes as above (Daley, P Silk, J Silk, Gleason).. Vote unanimous - Motion passed.

**Motion** by Dave Desmond, seconded by Brian Gleason to accept the four (4) membership applications above (Bowser, Hickey, Trepsas, and McQuaide). Vote unanimous - Motion passed.

**Motion** by Andrea Dutile, seconded by Brian Gleason to approve the six (6) changes listed above. Vote unanimous - Motion passed.

A list of Social members two (2) years in arrears, and one (1) year in arrears were reviewed – agreed, to expel the members two year in arrears, and send a letter to the members one year in arrears notifying them of their status.

**Motion** by Pat Donovan, seconded by Ray Costello to accept the Secretary's report. Vote unanimous - Motion passed.

### TREASURER'S REPORT

Sean distributed the November financial report and Cash Flow Chart as of 12/15/20 (attached). As of 12/15 Operating Account = \$48,130.39; Payroll Account = \$1,274.88; Money Market = \$0; Petty Cash = \$2,000.00; Line of Credit = \$50,000. \$50K was drawn down from the line of credit, which should carry us through the end of December.

Sean reported that if we refinanced our mortgage there would be a hefty prepayment penalty (on a commercial loan), and instead suggested we restructure our monthly payments (previously adjusted due to the irrigation project) over the course of the loan. This will not save money per se or change the length of the loan, but will free up approximately \$2K/month over the next few years.

**Motion** by Sean Moriarty, seconded by Brian Gleason to restructure our current loan payments, maintaining the same number of payments and length of the loan. Vote unanimous – Motion passed.

Other items for discussion: need to review cart fees for the new year (all new carts); consider closing the club house Mon. through Wed. until the season starts – need to determine cost savings, impacts to House, Pro Shop, members, etc.; Sean and Jay are working on a budget

with a proposed 4% dues increase – need to review with committee chairs and Finance Review Committee, must be approved next week (time and date TBD).

Initial list of Capital Expenses (preliminary Cap Ex budget at \$80K) for House and Course (all postponed from last year): rough mower; sidewinder; three (3) trees to be removed; landscape # 9 tee box; cart cover at barn (for new carts); repair awnings; improvements to phone and computer system.

**Motion** by Ray Costello, seconded by Andrea Dutile to accept the Treasurer's report. Vote unanimous – Motion passed.

#### HOUSE COMMITTEE

Donna McMahon reported the Festival of Trees was a success, with donations made to the Table of Plenty and Merrimack Valley Food Banks; also Bianco's Friday dinners have been very well attended while maintaining existing safety protocols; and Bianco's is interested in returning next year and working on improvements.

**Motion** by Dave Desmond, seconded by Pat Donovan to accept the House Committee report. Vote unanimous – Motion passed

#### GREENS COMMITTEE

Ray Costello reported there are currently three (3) full time employees, as in the past, and an understanding there is no overtime available; the other Course items were covered under the Treasurer's report.

**Motion** by Brian Gleason, seconded by Donna McMahon to accept the Greens Committee report. Vote unanimous – Motion passed

#### TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE

Brian Gleason met with Joel and staff to discuss getting through the winter, and begin planning for the upcoming season; also working with Joel on getting the Trakman setup upstairs (need to clarify hours, terms, etc. – there is to be no cost absorbed by Mount Pleasant).

**Motion** by Sean Moriarty, seconded by Pat Donovan to accept the Tournament Committee report. Vote unanimous – Motion passed

#### COMMUNICATIONS COMMITTEE

Pat Donovan explained there was only one email this week (Monday) due to a lack of information/material; will publicize yardage marker raffle and toys donation (this week); will do Friday dinner promotions if information is available.

**Motion** by Brian Gleason, seconded by Ray Costello to accept the report of the Communications Committee. Vote unanimous - Motion passed.
